<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Sweet Wine Flight \$14.99</u></b></p> <p><b>1) Willamette Valley Vineyards Riesling (Washington) Bottle \$22.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$7.99</b> - Take it Home for \$12.99                  Sweet Lemons to the nose with a bright light sweet citrus finish.</p> <p><b>2) St. Christopher Kabinett Riesling (Germany) Bottle \$20.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$7.99</b> - Take it Home for \$10.99                  A light sweetness is paired with citrus fragrances and a brightness that makes this wine fun to drink. Bright acidity makes this by far our best selling sweet.</p> <p><b>3) Enotria Moscato (Mendocino, CA) Bottle \$24.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$9.99</b> - Take it home for \$14.99                  This wine made from the Muscat grape has a fragrance of lemons Followed by citrus sweetness that lasts. Light notes of cherry and earth fill the senses combined with a soft light drink and a dark fruit finish.</p> <p><b>2) Castillo de Monséran Garnacha (Carinena Spain) Bottle \$20.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$7.99</b> - Take it Home for \$10.99                  From Spain comes this light and bright wine with flavors of cherry fruits and a hint of old world earthiness.</p> <p><b>3) Playmate Fetish Blend (Barossa Valley Australia) Bottle \$27.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$9.99</b> - Take it Home for \$17.99                  Shiraz, Mataro, Grenache blend for that classic big Aussie style of wine with Black Cherry flavors and a long big fruit finish.</p> <p><b>4) Allamand Malbec (Mendoza Argentina) Bottle \$29.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$10.99</b> - Take it Home for \$19.99                  Leather and Cherry combine to make this soft easy drinking wine with a perfect finish that just fades away cleanly. Enjoy the bright burst of lemons to the nose followed by a drink absent of those grapefruit and grassy notes. Very fresh.</p> <p><b>2) Sediato Torrontes (Argentina) Bottle \$19.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$7.99</b> - Take it Home for \$9.99                  A great light and overlooked grape with a very soft citrus nose followed by a light pleasant note of fresh fruit that lingers to the finish. Great with Seafood!</p> <p><b>3) Durnberg Falko White Blend (Austria) Bottle \$24.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$8.99</b> - Take it Home for \$14.99                  This blend of Gruner Veltliner, Riesling and Chardonnay has tangerine to the nose followed by a bright lively acidity that makes it fun to drink.</p> <p><b>4) Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio (Italy) Bottle \$37.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$14.99</b> - Take it Home for \$27.99                  This Pinot Grigio is one of Italy's finest. Big notes of fruit tease your senses on the nose only to be followed by the reality of a defined dryness to the finish.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Chardonnay Flight \$14.99</u></b></p> <p><b>1) Mackenzie Chardonnay (Sonoma, CA) Bottle \$23.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$8.99</b> - Take it Home for \$13.99                  Bright lemons to the nose followed a softer wine aged without Oak for a lighter finish.</p> <p><b>2) Chateau St. Jean Chardonnay (Sonoma CA) Bottle \$24.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$8.99</b> - Take it Home for \$14.99                  A seemingly softer Chard to the nose that finishes with a light hint of toast.</p> <p><b>3) Mercy Chardonnay (Arroyo Seco Monterey CA) Bottle \$34.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$11.99</b> - Take it Home for \$24.99                  Part of a new family of wines discovered during my last trip to California that we had to have. Butterscotch and tropical notes lead the senses followed by a light creaminess that finishes clean and light.</p> <p><b>4) J Lohr Arroyo Vista (Arroyo Seco /Monterey CA) Bottle \$30.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$11.99</b> - Take it Home for \$20.99                  This Chardonnay is elegant with rich butter notes blended together with a toasty oak finish. This is their 1<sup>st</sup> vintage of this elegant pinot with cherries in the drink and a soft a silky finish.</p> <p><b>2) The Troublemaker Red Blend (Paso Robles CA) Bottle \$26.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$9.99</b> - Take it Home for \$16.99                  A red blend of Syrah, Grenache, Petite Sirah and Mourvedre. A big beautiful deep and dark wine with Black Cherries to its base and a long big fruit finish. Not dry at all.</p> <p><b>3) Alma Negra Red Wine (Mendoza Argentina) Bottle \$30.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$11.99</b> - Take it Home for \$20.99                  85% Bonarda with a bit of Malbec and Cab Franc combine to produce a special wine with dark fruits with a pretty soft easy drinking finish. Elegant!</p> <p><b>4) Wild Thing Zinfandel (Mendocino CA) Bottle \$30.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$11.99</b> - Take it Home for \$20.99                  A cab lover's Zin with a taste of Bing Cherry fruit and a soft non-dry finish.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Cabernet Sauvignon Flight \$14.99</u></b></p> <p><b>1) CC Baby Cabernet (Napa Valley, CA) Bottle \$32.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$11.99</b> - Take it home for \$22.99                  A very soft wine with berry fruits in combination with a light earthiness to the finish.</p> <p><b>2) Educated Guess Cabernet (Napa Valley, CA) Bottle \$32.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$11.99</b> - Take it Home for \$22.99                  Big berry fruit nose that's enchanting just to smell, followed by a lasting fruit taste that's very 2<sup>nd</sup> glass friendly</p> <p><b>3) Sharecroppers Cabernet (Walla Walla, Wash) Bottle \$26.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$9.99</b> - Take it Home for \$16.99                  Dark deep Cherry fruit and classic cab berries combine for a soft dry finish.</p> <p><b>4) J Lohr Hilltop Cabernet (Paso Robles, CA) Bottle \$35.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$13.99</b> - Take it Home for \$25.99                  J Lohr's Premium Tier Cabernet from Paso Robles. The wine opens initially with strong leather notes and very earthy. After open for awhile it turns to bright raspberries mixed with a dark fruit body and a soft finish. Fun progression!</p> <p><b>2) Marchesi Biscardo Valpolicella (Italy) Bottle \$30.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$11.99</b> - Take it Home for \$20.99                  This Valpolicella blend is a Ripasso with soft raisin like fragrances, bright raspberries to the taste and a hint of spice to the finish.</p> <p><b>3) Villa Buonasera Sangiovese (Tuscany, Italy) Bottle \$29.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$10.99</b> - Take it Home for \$19.99                  This Sangiovese has that classic leathery nose followed by a hint of cherry fruit and a bigger dry finish. Classic pasta pair.</p> <p><b>4) Il Poggione Rosso Di Montalcino (Montalcino Italy) Bottle \$36.99*</b>  <b>Glass Pour \$13.99</b> - Take it Home for \$26.99                  The wine is considered a young Brunello of 100% Sangiovese. Leather to the nose with red fruits on the palate and a dry finish.
